Community Involvement

The Toasters take the idea of engaging the community very seriously. To do this, they participate in several outreach events and volunteer with local charity organizations.

The team helps to put on STEAM Classes at the local library, where they invite K-5th graders to participate in fun-filled activities centered around Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics. They also host Girl Scout nights, volunteer to make Easter Baskets for those in underprivileged situations with Families Building Faith, and unload trucks for Blessings in a Backpack. These are only a few of the many activities that they are involved in. Team members are enthusiastic to help out whenever they can and to be a part of their community!

Build Team's Projects

Bag and Tag was February 21st. The team has to seal their robot as-is in a plastic bag and cannot touch it until the day of their first competition. The team planned out their six week build season using a new method for the team: a tactical plan. Through this, they were able to assign responsibilities and make sure that each step of making the robot was covered, from programming to mechanical. Now that the competition robot is sealed away, the build team is working on finishing up their practice robot in order to continue making progress and practicing the game!

Chairman's Projects

The Chairman's team was also working towards a deadline: their essay submissions were due February 9th. The team worked to finish their essay and executive summaries, and actually finished them a week early this year due to the help of their mentors and tactical plan! They finalized and bound their Impact Study, a collection of all their outreach events. Now that competitions are coming up, the Chairman's team is focused on presentations and a video for the year!












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Sponsor Spotlight On: Pratt & Miller
